Picking a Popular Trim Size for Your Book. If Random House, Simon & Schuster, and HarperCollins all agree that 6x9 is not a great trim size for general fiction paperbacks, then your 6x9 general fiction paperback will look a little out of place.

Self-Publishing Basics: How to Pick the Size of your Book

The size and proportions of a book will thus depend on the size of the original sheet of paper used in producing the book. For example, if a sheet 19 inches (480 mm) by 25 inches (640 mm) is used to print a quarto, the resulting book will be approximately 12 1/2 inches (320 mm) tall and 9 1/2 inches (240 mm) wide, before trimming.

The most common trim size for paperbacks in the U.S. is 6" x 9" (15.24 x 22.86 cm). When setting up your book, this is the default in the "Print Options" section of the Paperback Content tab. If you want a different trim size, click Select a different size and choose from standard and non-standard trim sizes.

The standard book size is six inches wide and nine inches tall (6"x 9"). Your book will probably be cheapest to print, easiest to read, and easiest to sell (e.g., it'll fit on bookstore shelves) in this size.

Most self-published books are trade paperbacks. Manuals and workbooks are larger and, depending on the printing equipment being used to produce them, are in the 8" x 10" to 8-1/2" x 11" range. This size is also good for directories and instructional books with lots of graphics or detailed drawings to follow.

Trade paperbacks: The better-quality books you might pick up in a Barnes & Noble bookstore, trade paperbacks are probably what you picture when you think of a paperback book. Trade paperback sizes will range anywhere from 5.5" x 8.5" (a size that's called digest) to 6" x 9" (also known as US trade).

A trade paperback book is a large paperback--about 5 inches by 7 inches or slightly larger. A soft back book is any book without a rigid (hardback) cover.

Color books have the same trims available and print books between eight and 250 pages. The most common trim sizes for standard trade fiction and nonfiction books include: 5" x 8", 5.5" x 8.5", and 6" x 9". But there are a number of other trim size options you can choose from, shown in the chart below.
