To use wdeploy to deploy BusinessObjects web applications on web application servers, an administration instance of the web application server must be started because wdeploy uses the administration tool of each of the web application server (except Tomcat).

### **Add an SAP entitlement system to BusinessObjects Enterprise**

Using the BI4 installer, install the BI4 web tier on the machine hosting the webapp server. Patch this installation up to your required patch level. Then deploy to web app server using wdeploy GUI or command line. Notes regarding deployment to SAP NW Java AS 7.3. SAP NW Java AS 7.3 is supported from and only from BI 4.0 SP01 patch 01.
