Tenants may withhold rent, move out without notice, sue the landlord, call state or local health inspectors, or exercise the right to “repair and deduct” if a landlord fails to take care of important repairs, such as a broken heater. Before evicting a tenant, California law requires a landlord to legally terminate the tenancy. To do this, the landlord must first give the tenant written notice, as specified by state law.

The only way a landlord can legally evict a tenant in California is by filing an eviction lawsuit with the court and receiving a court order allowing the eviction to occur. Before filing the eviction lawsuit, the landlord must first give the tenant notice that the tenant did something wrong and that an eviction may occur.

Tenant Rights in California Evictions Landlords in California have the right to evict a tenant who has failed to live up to his or her end of the contractual agreement. To do so, the landlord must file with the court, and the court then presents eviction documents to the tenant, who then has five days to respond to the eviction papers.

Once you end your lease and leave your apartment, California law gives your landlord 21 days to return your security deposit or give you an itemized statement detailing what he used the money for.
