A rubric is a grading guide that makes explicit the criteria for judging students' work on discussion, a paper, performance, product, show-the-work problem, portfolio, presentation, essay question—any student work you seek to evaluate. Rubrics inform students of expectations while they are learning.

Characteristics to note in the rubric:
Language is descriptive, not evaluative.
Labels for degrees of success are descriptive (“Expert” “Proficient”, etc.);
by avoiding the use of letters representing grades or numbers representing points, there is no implied contract that qualities of the paper will “add up” to a specified score or grade or that all dimensions are of equal grading ...

GRADING RUBRIC FOR PHILOSOPHY PAPERS I. Argumentation (40%)

Good scoring rubrics: Consist of a checklist of items, each with an even number of points. For example, two-point rubrics would indicate that the student either did or did not perform the

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specified task. Four or more points in a rubric are common and indicate the degree to which a student performed a given task.
