GUIDED READING Preamble and Article 1

The Constitution guarantees "no state, without its consent, shall be deprived of its equal suffrage in the Senate" (Article V). Members were originally chosen by the state legislatures in each state. Since 1913, the Seventeenth Amendment allows for the direct election of senators by the people of the state.

The president pro tempore, or pro tem, is the Senate leader who presides over the Senate in the absence of the vice president. The president pro tem is elected by the Senate from the majority party and is usually the party's longest-serving member. C. The most important Senate officers are the majority and minority leaders, both of whom are elected by party members.
