Hadrian's Library was created by Roman Emperor Hadrian in AD 132 on the north side of the Acropolis of Athens. [1] [2] The building followed a typical Roman Forum architectural style, having only one entrance with a propylon of Corinthian order , a high surrounding wall with protruding niches (oikoi , exedrae) at its long sides, an inner courtyard surrounded by columns and a decorative oblong pool in the middle.
