5775 (Hebrew: ה"עשת"ה , abbr.: ה"עש"ת) is a Hebrew year that will start in the evening before September 25, 2014, and will end on September 13, 2015. This year has 354 days. It is a common year in the Hebrew Metonic cycle, with a single Adar month. It is a Shmita year.

This year (September 25, 2014 - September 13, 2015) is 5775 on the Hebrew calendar because the Jews count their years from 3761/3760 BC. That is the year of the commencement of the lunisolar calendar, not the year of Creation.
