Use Polycell Overlap & Repair Adhesive in a tube. Remember to wipe away any excess adhesive squeezed out when the wallpaper is pressed back into place. If the wallpaper is thick or heavily curled, it pays to wet it with a sponge - this makes it more flexible and easier to work with.

Which wallpaper paste to use for specfic wallpapers and ...

Excessive rolling of seams forcing adhesive from behind wallpaper. Failure to apply adhesive to edges when pasting. Allowing paste to dry on edges while booking. Solution: Loose seams can usually be re-affixed using wallpaper adhesive. Curling or Loose Ends. Causes: Improper wall preparation, i.e. not sealed or no sizing. Not enough adhesive used.

Loose wallpaper has a tendency to curl, especially vinyl papers, so the longer you wait to do the repair, the less chance that a little glue and deft finger work will fix it! Case in point... you apply the adhesive, press the wallpaper in place, and merrily go on to redrywall your living room.

4 Easy Wallpaper Fixes. Here's how to get rid of that bubble: Using a sharp utility knife, cut a small slit in the paper along one side of the bubble. Insert the injector's needle into the slit, and squeeze seam adhesive under the bubble. Press out excess adhesive and wipe it off with a damp sponge. Roll gently with a wallpaper seam roller to flatten the bubble.

Wallpaper Seam Repair

If the bubble is in fact just air, you can fix the problem with a glue-injecting syringe which is available at most paint stores and home centers like Home Depot and Lowes. Fill the syringe with some thinned down ready mixed adhesive, cut a straight small slit with a razor knife (this way you won't stretch the wallcovering) and squirt in the adhesive.

If the wallpaper patch is prepasted paper, soak it in warm water for 30 seconds. Then "book" it by folding it over, paste to paste, to activate the adhesive. Let it set for about five minutes, then peel it apart and press the patch to the wall.

Which wallpaper paste to use for specific wallpapers and surfaces. The cleanest option which leaves the least glue residue is double-sided (for glass: transparent) tape which is applied to the 4 edges of the surface to be wallpapered. For larger areas, another strip of sticky tape should be applied to the middle, too.

Immediate Action. When you're noticing curled seams shortly after hanging a length of textured wallpaper, the fix might be a simple one. The installer may be taking too long, fussing with a wet length of paper to get it straight, or he may be working in a hot room. Both scenarios can cause the adhesive to dry out or lose its tackiness.
