Ashes of Buddha were found in a gold bottle wrapped in silk cloth within a copper bowl that was kept in a casket. The 1,700-year-old casket's inscription in Brahmi script mentions 'Dashabala Sharira Nilaya' — which stands for 'abode of the bodily relics of Lord Buddha'.

The three-prongs symbolize the “Three Jewels” (Sanbō 三寶), which are the Buddha, the Dharma (Buddhist law), and the Sangha (community of Buddhist believers). The six prongs of this weapon (three on each side) are sometimes said to represent the six realms of karmic rebirth.
