2020 Release of Journal Citation Reports. The 2020 Edition of the Journal Citation Reports® (JCR) published by Clarivate Analytics provides a combination of impact and influence metrics from 2019 Web of Science source data. This measure provides a ratio of citations to a journal in a given year to the citable items in the prior two years.

The Lancet's 2013 impact factor is 39.207, ranking the journal second in the general medicine category. It's very difficult to be published in The Lancet. Only 5% of submitted manuscripts accepted for publication in the Lancet family of nine general medicine specialty journals.

The median impact factor is the median value of all journals impact factors in the subject category. The journal impact factor extenuates the significance of absolute citation frequencies.

Journal Impact Factor

During 2017, the Journal Citation Reports (JCR) database tracked all impact factors for 12,298 journals. The table below shows the number and percentage of journals that were assigned impact factors ranging from 0 to 10+. Of 12,298 journals, only 239 titles, or 1.9% of the journals tracked by JCR, have a 2017 impact factor of 10 or higher.

Journal Impact Factors - Annual Reviews

Journals may also attempt to limit the number of "citable items"—i.e., the denominator of the impact factor equation—either by declining to publish articles that are unlikely to be cited (such as case reports in medical journals) or by altering articles (e.g., by not allowing an abstract or bibliography in hopes that Journal Citation Reports will not deem it a "citable item").
