The Lancet's 2013 impact factor is 39.207, ranking the journal second in the general medicine category. It's very difficult to be published in The Lancet. Only 5% of submitted manuscripts accepted for publication in the Lancet family of nine general medicine specialty journals.

An aggregate journal impact factor of 1.0 implies that the articles in the subject category published in recent two years have been cited once on an average. The median value of all journals impact factors in the subject category. The journal impact factor extenuates the significance of absolute citation frequencies.

During 2017, the Journal Citation Reports (JCR) database tracked all impact factors for 12,298 journals. The table below shows the number and percentage of journals that were assigned impact factors ranging from 0 to 10+. Of 12,298 journals, only 239 titles, or 1.9% of the journals tracked by JCR, have a 2017 impact factor of 10 or higher.
