A motion to reopen is an important statutory mechanism for people who have been ordered removed. See 8 U.S.C. § 1229a(c)(7). It allows these individuals to ask either the immigration judge (IJ) or the BIA to consider material and previously unavailable evidence and vacate the existing order. See 8 C.F.R. §§ 1003.2(c); 1003.23(b)(3).

When to File a Motion to Reopen an Immigration Matter A motion to reopen is appropriate only when the case deserves a fresh look because something has changed or new information has come to light. If you file a motion to reopen your case, that motion should: assert new material facts

## **Immigration Case Denied: When to File Motion to Reopen or ...**

A motion to reopen is a request to the original decision maker to review a decision. The motion must be based on factual grounds, such as the discovery of new evidence or changed circumstances, and “state the new facts to be provided in the reopened proceedings and be supported by affidavits or other documentary evidence.”

## **Immigration Law | MTR - Motion to Reconsider or Reopen**

A motion to reopen must provide “new facts that will be proven at a hearing to be held if the motion is granted and shall be supported by affidavits and other evidentiary material.” 8 C.F.R. § 1003.23(b)(3).
