Introduction. Patient satisfaction is an important metric to assess overall quality of the services delivered (1). The Hospital Consumer Assessment of Healthcare Providers and Systems was introduced in 2006 by the US government in an effort to standardize the survey instrument and data collection methodology for measuring the patient experience (CMS.gov) (2).
