1954. Rationing continued even after the war ended: Meat rationing continued for 10 years after D-Day (June 1954) In 1946, when food was just as short as during the preceding years, bread was added to the ration and the sweet ration was halved.

The work of issuing ration books and exchanging used stamps for certificates was handled by some 5,500 local ration boards of mostly volunteer workers selected by local officials.
