These assessments are designed to measure children's knowledge of important literacy fundamentals and can be used as a diagnostic tool to provide teachers with explicit information to help guide their

teaching.

A running record is a record of reading behaviors that students make as they are reading. As a child reads a portion of a book, the teacher notes errors, selfcorrections, rereadings, hesitations and appeals for help.

A running record is an informal check of oral reading accuracy. The procedure for taking a running record is described on the PALS website. This site also provides links to a downloadable running record form and a coding guide that explains how to record a student's oral reading

When you perform a running record, simply use the symbols and marking conventions explained in Table 1 below to record a child's reading behavior as

A running record gives the teacher an indication of whether material currently being read is too easy or too difficult for the child, and it serves as an indicator of the areas where a child's reading can

improve. Running records can also give an indication of reading fluency, including speed, accuracy, and prosody.
