Automaticity refers only to accurate, speedy word recognition, not to reading with expression. Therefore, automaticity (or automatic word recognition) is necessary, but not sufficient, for fluency. Fluency instruction. Fluency is not a stage of development at which readers can read all words quickly and easily.

Activities that give students "time" to derive the fact will not help develop automaticity of math facts. Automaticity is developed when students learn to answer facts instantly from

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recall. Developing that ability takes a systematic effort over time. Teachers need a tool to help them do that.

Teaching Sight Words as a Part of Comprehensive Reading ...

Staple sets of five together and highlight and read one a day in guided reading. Each day, read the previous day's page. This will promote fluency and automaticity. Send home the stapled sets each night in their homework bags to practice. Add to a literacy tub to highlight and partner read.

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
